

**RECYCLING in the Town of Lowell:****December, 2018**

The following information is to let you know what is and is not accepted at the Town waste disposal site.

Please remember that this site is for Town of Lowell residents only. The hours for waste to be accepted are from **9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Saturdays ONLY.**

**Please bring your garbage in clear plastic bags. Check in and pay the attendant before dumping your garbage.**

**MAJOR APPLIANCES** – Limited to 4 per household per year.

Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, washers, dryers, stoves, microwaves and scrap metals are now being accepted.

**WASTE ENGINE OIL** will be accepted – Please see attendant.

**THE FOLLOWING ITEMS CAN NOT BE ACCEPTED:**

**LEAD ACID BATTERIES & WASTE TIRES:** These items must be disposed of at retail outlets or at other legal disposal locations. Check the DNR website: [www.dnr.wi.gov](http://www.dnr.wi.gov) for disposal locations.

**E-WASTE:** Computers, monitors, printers, televisions, VCR's, DVD players, fax machines & cell phones **can not** be accepted.

**Residents have the option of paying Advanced Disposal, or someone else, for home garbage pick-up service.**

**FEES** For Dumpster at Town Recycling Center (Solid Waste) ***Please use clear bags!!!***

\$ 1.00 per bag, up to 16 Gallon - \$ 2.00 per 16 Gallon to 32 Gallon bag - \$ 3.00 per 32 Gallon to 55 Gallon bag

\$ 5.00 per Mattress - \$ 25.00 for a load in a pickup truck or trailer (8 feet or larger will be charged more)

**Other fees will be up to the discretion of the attendant on duty!**

**Recyclables** – no charge ***Please*** take recyclables out of bags

GLASS	Bottles & Jars Only  any color	Remove lids & rings  Rinse clean	windows, mirrors, light bulbs, dishes, glassware, chemical bottles, medical containers, laboratory glass
ALUMINUM	Cans Only	Rinse clean	Foil, pie plates, bottle caps
TIN & STEEL CANS	Cans Only	Rinse clean	cardboard sided juice cans, aerosol cans, paint cans
PLASTIC	Food containers  marked 1 or 2	Rinse clean  Remove & discard lids	plastic bags, plastic wrap, oil bottles, styrofoam cups, plastic cups & film hard plastic (toys,pails, etc.) medicine bottles, syringes
NEWSPAPERS	Newspaper Only	Tie with string into bundles no larger than 8" high or place in paper bags	Newspaper with paint, oil, etc. on it
MAGAZINES	Magazines Only	Same as newspaper	Wax coated paper
CARDBOARD	All types of clean cardboard including cereal boxes	Flatten boxes  Tie in bundles	Cardboard contaminated with oil,  paint or food waste example: pizza boxes
OFFICE PAPER	Office paper & envelopes	Must be clean Put in paper bags	Bathroom wastepaper, food waste & wrappers
